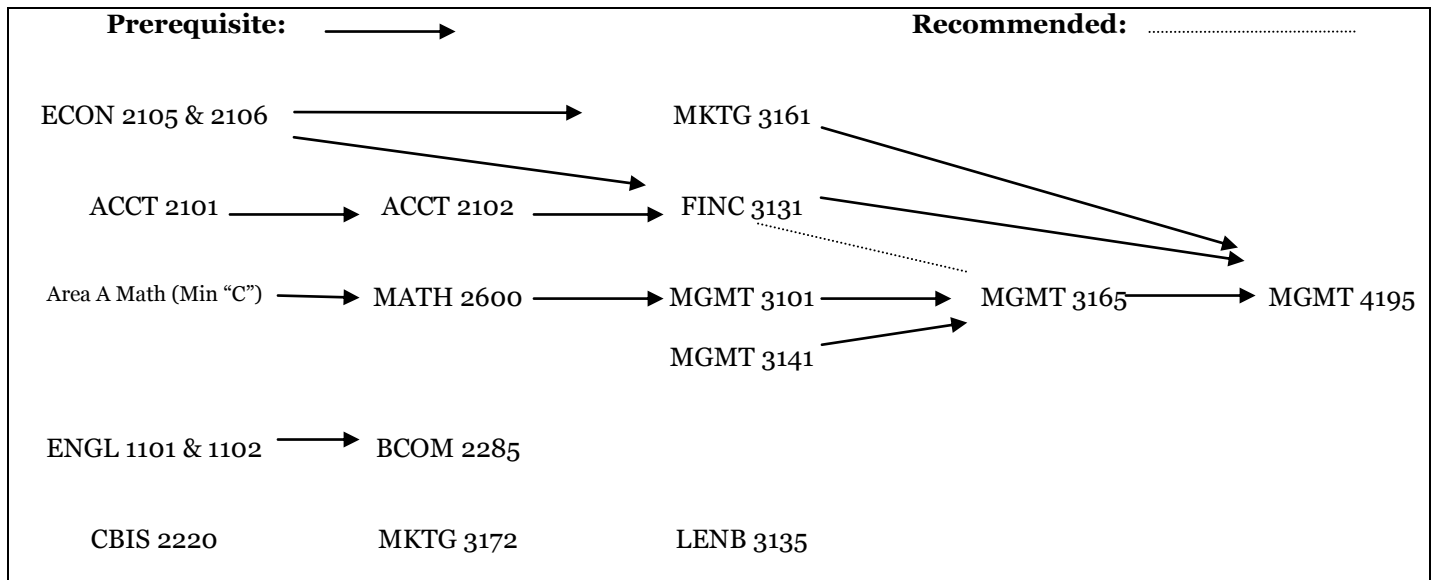

Notes
