## **Guide to Using MLA Style: Electronic Sources**

MLA (Modern Language Association) is a type of documentation style that is used for the pedagogical disciplines in the humanities.

## **Common Electronic Sources**

- E-book: Author last-name, Author first-name. Book Title. E-book, Publisher, Year of latest publication.
- Database source: Author last-name, Author first-name. "Title." Title of container (self contained if book), Other contributors (edited by/translated by), Version (edition), Number (vol. and/or no.), Publisher, Publication Date, Location (pages, paragraphs and/or URL, DOI or permalink). 2nd container's title, Other contributors, Version, Number, Publisher, Publication date, Location, accessed Day Month Year (if applicable).
- Entire website: Author/compiler name (if available). Name of Site. Version number (if available), Name of institution/organization of site (sponsor/publisher), date of resource creation (if available), accessed Day Month Year (if applicable), DOI (if available, if not use URL).
- Individual webpage: Author last-name Author first-name. "Title of page/article." Publisher, URL/ DOI. Accessed Day Month Year (if applicable).
- Film: Title. Directed by Director 1, performances by Lead actors' names, Film studio/ distributor, Year of release.
- Entire TV series: Last-name, First-name and First-name Last-name, creators. Title. Production company, Years in production.
- Episode of TV series: "Name of Episode." Title of series, written by Author's first-name last-name, directed by Director's name, Distribution company, Date of distribution.
- Episode of a TV series on a streaming platform: "Name of Episode." Title of series, Season Number, Episode Number, Network, Date of release. Format of Episode (Netflix/HULU/ etc).
