The Bachelor of Arts in History teaches students to think critically and encourages them to write clearly and cogently on historical topics while conducting historical research. The study of history also prepares one directly for many occupations and indirectly for many more. History is an excellent background subject for those going into teaching, the law, the ministry, journalism and media work. Many business positions are open to history majors, especially those requiring breadth of knowledge, research and writing ability and skill in organizing information.

The Department of History and Geography offers a special certificate in Global Foodways Studies. Earning a certificate in foodways studies will help you find employment with government agencies dealing with food and agriculture issues, food-oriented non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that work on sustainability and food security issues, and food processing, preparation, and distribution firms.
