## Dean Peters:

This letter proposes the implementation of a three course ESOL Endorsement concentration in the Department of Professional Learning and Innovation. Here are some details about the proposed ESOL Endorsement Concentration:

- Courses can be offered for our students during the summer, Maymester and/or Saturdays.
- Each ESOL course is 3 credit hours.
- Courses are scheduled to begin Summer semester 2018.
- No new faculty will be needed to implement the ESOL Endorsement Concentration.
- The ESOL Endorsement Concentration is aimed at the Undergraduate Education Cohorts, but will be open to students who would like to take them.
- The ESOL endorsement requires certification as a teacher to go into effect. That is, only successful teacher candidates will be able to earn an endorsement in ESOL
- Others students can take the courses for content knowledge provided or who plan to teach in international situations where endorsement from the state of Georgia is unnecessary.
- There is no prerequisite order for taking the ESOL courses.
- It is anticipated that the ESOL courses will have both online and face-to-face instruction.

There is a window of time wherein to gain developmental approval for the "embedded" endorsements (concurrent with an initial certification program) for our initial certification candidates. This window and approval is contingent on our existing approved graduate endorsement program in ESOL. The proposed ESOL courses will allow the candidates who take them to graduate with ESOL endorsement at the same time as their initial certificate. Several school districts in the Atlanta area have indicated priority hiring to candidates with endorsements in hand. Hence, now is the time to add this option for undergraduates.
