New Orleans Feby 12th 1847

To his Excellency the Governor

Of the State of Georgia

Sir:

Having received the appointment of Commissioner of Deeds for the State of Louisiana in Texas from his Excy. Gov, Johnson. I write to solicit the same appointment for the State of Georgia.

The increasing intercourse between the States of Georgia and Texas, and the number of Citizens of the former who are daily removing to, and settling in the latter, render it necess-ary + important that some one should be appointed to act in a recognized official capacity for the interest of all parties.
