Dr. Kristina Dandy is a Professor of Psychology in the Department of Psychological Science. She earned her Ph.D. in Experimental Psychology from Texas Christian University with a focus on animal models of learning and behavior with specific research interests in delay-discounting as a measure of impulsive choice. Since arriving at Georgia College, she has also regularly collaborated with colleagues in the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL). Her work can be found in the *Journal of Behavioural Pharmacology* and *The International Journal of Teaching and Learning in Higher Education*. In addition to her active involvement in mentoring undergraduate students in research, she teaches courses in statistics for behavioral sciences, psychology of learning, and behavioral pharmacology. Her previous leadership experience includes chairing both the University Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee and the Individual Faculty Review Committee for the Department of Psychological Science. Currently she serves on the College of Arts and Sciences Curriculum Instruction Committee and Tenure and Promotion Committee and chairs the Individual Faculty Review Revision Committee for the Department of Psychological Science.
