Dr. Linda Golson Bradley, a Professor of Literacy Instruction in the Department of Professional Learning and Innovation, earned her Ph.D. in Elementary Education with a Concentration in Literacy from the University of Alabama. She teaches courses in literacy development, literacy instruction, literacy assessment, and diverse reading and writing profiles. Her research focuses on the beliefs and practices of effective writing teachers as well as integrating the arts within literacy. She has secured over \$300,000 in external grant funding and \$50,000 in internal grant funding while at Georgia College. Dr. Bradley has served on University Senate, the University Strategic Task Force, and the Institutional Review Board. Her leadership has included interim roles to support the launch of the Sandra Dunagan Deal Center for Early Language and Literacy, and to chair the Department of Professional Learning & Innovation.
