The Art department at Georgia College prepares you to be an art practitioner with skills and values that make you an active and responsible participant in society. They will prepare you to engage in questions of self-expression, artisanship, identity, community, values, politics, and meaning. The major balances studio work, history and theory courses to organize them around a combination of activities. These include: various teaching methods in your courses, visiting artist experiences, exposure to contemporary art through the Galleries on campus, independent learning opportunities, and a senior project. The classes are small with a low faculty to student ratio. You will be encouraged to explore media from the tradition of paints to the precision of pixels. The for main objectives are historical and contemporary analytical skills, audience understanding, production skills, and critical and evaluative skills.
