Major in Economics

The Bachelor of Science in Economics program is designed to prepare students as competent economists ready for successful careers in business or government, graduate school in economics, or professional school studying business or law. As a student in this program, you'll take a range of courses including macroeconomics, microeconomics, public speaking, international trade and more.

Because the economics program is relatively small, economics students often work through their program of study in "cohorts" which makes the classroom atmosphere informal and collegial. Upperlevel economics courses usually have fewer than 25 students which helps facilitate student-professor interaction. The Economics major includes 30 elective hours of coursework. This provides a unique opportunity for students to complete a minor or a second major within four years of study.
