**Welcome to the GC Community Dance 2022-2023 program!!** This is the 28th anniversary year of the dance program at GC! We are so excited about the year ahead! Welcome returning students and our new students too. You should have gotten a fall dance letter in June or when you registered. Attached to this letter is the yearly calendar. Please keep it in a safe place and refer to it as the year progresses.

**Reminders:** Please remember that **dance shoes** are not to be worn outside and should be carried into dance class and then put on. **Please put your name in all shoes.** Every year we have a large box of lost and found articles. Please put your **hair up** for dance class. Dancers with very long hair should have it up completely and not just in a pony tail. Pony tails get in the way while turning. Dancers cannot learn with hair in the face. Remember to **wear only dance wear** to class, and not sportswear such as shorts. Dance wear helps the instructors to see the body the best and also looks professional. **Solid color leotards, tights, and an optional sheer dance skirt are required. Remember to wear a cover-up to and from class too. Please try to be on time for class.** If you miss a class you may make it up in a lower level class. St. Stephens, will wear whatever they wear to school that day, to class. There are just too many students for the instructors to change their clothes before dance class. Those students do need ballet shoes however, worn with thin socks. Girls wear pink and boys wear black ballet shoes. Hip hop students may purchase jazz dance sneakers at BoBo's Dance Wear in Macon or on line at site such as Discount Dance.

**Parents please check the bulletin boards** and walls at the studios for important notices. E mails are sent out on a weekly basis and sometimes several times a week. **Please make sure the registration office has your correct E mail address or you will miss out on important announcements!!** That is our best way of communication with you! ALL letters this year will be sent by e mail.

**Dance Shoes:** All students need pink ballet shoes for ballet classes and black jazz shoes for the jazz classes. Black tap shoes for tap classes will be needed as well. These are the shoes that will be needed for the Nutcracker and spring concert. BoBos Dance Wear in Macon is the closest retail store for dance wear. There are also sites on line such as Discount Dance Supply.

**Please remember that tuition payments are due by the first lesson of the month. Your dancer will be denied admittance to class if tuition is not paid.** You can pay in the registration office, Chappell Hall, call it in at (478) 445 – 5277 and put it on your credit card, or the preferred method: online: [gcsu.edu/community-dance](http://gcsu.edu/community-dance). A \$20.00 registration fee per family should have already been paid. **Students must have their tuition completely paid up to date before dancing in productions.**

**Plans for our 26<sup>th</sup> anniversary Nutcracker are well under way.** Please check the bulletin board by the studio for the cast list that will be posted by Labor Day. Photographs of the costumes will soon be posted by the dance studio doors in both studios and at St. Stephens. Soon you will receive information about the costumes and an order form by e mail. You will receive a

Nutcracker rehearsal schedule very soon. Rehearsals will begin right after Labor Day! **Costume orders are due Friday, September 9.**

**Parents, please try and be on time picking up your child after class.** We try very hard to dismiss students on time. It is impossible to watch children in the lobby area and teach at the same time! The instructors cannot be responsible for children left in the building after class is dismissed. This is very important for the Chappell Hall studio as the instructors often are trying to get to their own technique class in Miller and cannot wait. **Students left over 15 minutes after a class will have an immediate fine of \$20.** Students left when the instructor is leaving to go home will be taken to Public Safety. This will be strictly enforced this year again.

# **GC Community Dance Program Studio Rules**

## **2022 - 2023**

- 1. Please try to be on time to class. It is important for the students to participate in the warm-ups at the beginning of class!**
- 2. Proper attire consists of solid color leotard and tights, sheer dance skirt (optional), and ballet, tap, pointe, or jazz shoes. Each dancer **MUST** have her hair securely held back away from the face. No excessive jewelry please. No shorts and tee shirts in class.**
- 3. Absolutely no gum, food, or drinks allowed in the dance studios. Water bottles with lids are allowed. Use the lobby area for eating and drinking.**
- 4. Please wear a cover-up to and from class. Never wear dance shoes outside!**
- 5. Put your name in all articles brought to class and to the theatre.**
- 6. Use the studio phone only during the period between classes, and only for an emergency. **NO CELL PHONES in class!!!****
- 7. Parents: please pick up students promptly after class! Students waiting to be picked up should wait in the lobby area and not outside. After a student is left for a 15 minute period or longer after class there will be immediate fine of \$20. We **CANNOT** supervise children left in the lobby.**
- 8. Sorry, but no visitors are allowed in class. We will make every effort to open the door at the end of class so that parents can peek in to see what we are doing that day.**
- 9. Proper classroom etiquette includes: proper attire, no gum, no talking, no sitting down or hanging on the barres between exercises. Please go to the bathroom between or before classes!**
- 10. Tuition, payable to GC, is due by the FIRST day on the month. Students cannot dance in productions if tuition is owed. Students are not allowed into class when they are behind in tuition. Tuition can be paid by credit card if you call the CE office at (478) 445 – 5277, or on line: [gcsu.edu/community-dance](http://gcsu.edu/community-dance)**
- 11. Promotion is decided upon on an individual basis by the instructor in regard to ability, age, maturity, and work habits of the student. Promotion to another class cannot be given if a student has been absent more than 1/3 of the year.**
- 12. Nutcracker parts are given based upon dedication to dance, work**

habits, class attendance, age-appropriateness, talent, attitude, and is the sole responsibility of the director. Solos are generally given to the top students in the highest level of technique class.

13. **All dance bags, school book bags, and personal articles should be taken into the dance studio and NOT left out in the hall. The GC Community Dance program is not responsible for student's personal belongings.**
14. **Pointe shoes are given on an individual basis based upon age, correct posture, weight, years of study in ballet, over all technique level, maturity, and dedication to dance.**
15. **The instructors and director of the program are happy to meet with parents at any time to discuss the progress of their student.**
16. **Generally speaking, when GC is closed, our dance program is closed.** This would be due to holidays or inclement weather. An e mail will be sent out notifying students and parents. Since we have so many students in so many different schools, we will follow the spring break schedule of GC, not the one for the public schools. We do NOT observe fall break.
