Dr. Joy Bracewell directs the Writing Center at GCSU and earned her Ph.D. in English from the University of Georgia. During her first year as Director, she increased the annual budget of the Writing Center by 288%, spearheading its move into an updated space with new technology in Arts & Sciences through the support of university administration. The First Year Writing Task force, Composition Committee, Writing in the Disciplines Faculty Learning Community, and site visit of the Writing Program Administrators Consultant-Evaluator Service are all initiatives she has led to enhance the teaching and praxis of writing. She has taught introductory writing, graduate pedagogy and literary theory seminars, and courses on British and World literature. Her research focuses on Writing Center Studies, Visual Culture, and Nineteenth-Century Literature; she is co-editing a forthcoming collection on Writing Center Administrators as campus leaders.
