 - Revised MAcc Program Proposal: Adding Six Hours of Data Analytics Course.
 - The courses will address new requirements for CPA exam. Doesn't change the overall number of credit hours because it replaces some of the electives.
 - Scott moved to approve the proposal. Winston seconded the motion. Proposal was approved unanimously.
 - Early Childhood Education_Name Change_MEd Program.
 - Lyndall: Name change from "Early Childhood" to "Elementary Education Program" to align with the rest of the state and to align with what is printed on their teaching certificate. Name change will be phased in: 2023 and 2024

completers will have option of Early Childhood or Elementary Education. After 2024 it will automatically be Elementary Education.
