Those dancers having multiple Sat. or Sun. rehearsals who miss more than 2 rehearsals will be replaced: This includes the party scene, soldier scenes, Lamb Chops, and other dances. Dancers who have only one or two weekend rehearsals may not miss a weekend rehearsal!

* Everyone is responsible for checking this rehearsal schedule thoroughly. Do not expect your instructor to remind you of rehearsals. All understudies are expected to attend all rehearsals for their parts. No exceptions. All dancers attending rehearsals on weekends should be fifteen minutes early so that you can warm-up!!! If you don't do this it will make all the rehearsals following yours late for that day! YOU MUST WARM UP!!!



REMINDERS:

- 1. Arrive 15 minutes prior to your first rehearsal time in your costume with your hair properly secured (no make-up needed).
- 2. Report to your check in area and wait to be escorted to the stage. If in Lanier, enter through Lanier Hall and not the front of Russell. Parents must stay with students for levels III and younger. Levels IV and up must be dropped off by a parent to their designated check in area and picked up on time from the staging area.

3. If not already in the audience, dancers take all belongings to set in the audience seats when going on stage for the last rehearsal of the day. The dressing room will be already occupied by the next group. This will help us avoid congestion in small spaces. Dancers are responsible for the safety of their belongings.
