

WHAT IS A POSTER?

Posters are static, visual media (usually on a board or paper) that students use to communicate their research.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A POSTER AND A PAPER PRESENTATION?

During a poster presentation, the student should let the poster do the talking. The material on the poster should convey the essence of the message.

SHOULD I BE PRESENT TO SHOW MY POSTER?

Absolutely! Students must be present during their poster presentation to answer questions and provide insights.

HOW LONG SHOULD MY PRESENTATION BE?

Poster presentations should be about 2-3 minutes.

HOW BIG SHOULD MY POSTER BE?

Posters must be landscape or portrait, 48"x 36" (One PowerPoint slide) or under.
