

FLAGS OF THE OLD GOVERNOR'S MANSION



The twenty-seven-star American Flag was in use from 1845-1846. The twenty-seventh star represents the State of Florida, which was admitted on March 3, 1845.



This is the first Georgia State Flag and was adopted in 1799 after the creation of the Georgia Seal. The Georgia Seal was placed on a field of solid blue and included the state motto of "Wisdom, Justice, and Moderation." This state flag was used from 1799 through the Civil War.



This is the First Confederate National Flag - nicknamed the "Stars and Bars." It was adopted in 1861 by the first seven states that seceded and initially formed the Confederate States of America: South Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, and Texas. These states were represented by the seven stars on the flag.
