GC1Y/2Y proposals:
Consideration and discussion of GC2Y proposal from Dr. Cynthia Alby, Teacher Education. "Re-imagining education: lessons from across the globe". Proposal was unanimously approved (with minor changes to SACS requirements) by the committee, and will be routed to upper administration.

GC1Y/2Y Course Syllabus rubric audit and "calibration":
All GC1Y/2Y syllabi have been received for the purposes of conducting the program audit, save for 2 courses. Discussion of review process and audit assignments for the 113 collected syllabi, to be distributed among voting members of the committee. Example syllabi were considered for feedback in the meeting, as a means of training and refreshing members on use of the rubric provided by the Provost. One suggestion for additional criteria on the rubric was shared (addressing "Core IMPACTS").
