

Shopping List

What's Provided?

Residence hall rooms are furnished with an extra-long twin size bed (80 in. mattress), dresser, desk and chair, bookshelf, and window blinds. Apartments at The Village are furnished with a full-size mattress, dresser, desk and chair, bookshelf and window blinds. In addition, common areas in the apartments are furnished with a couch, chair, entertainment cube, side table and

coffee table. For more details about what is permitted in the residence halls or at The Village, please review the Housing Handbook.

Highly recommended:

- High Efficiency (HE) laundry detergent and fabric softener
- Push pins to hang posters
- Personal paperwork (Social Security card, copies of prescriptions and insurance cards)
- Wastebasket and trash bags, additional bin for recycling
- Surge protector
- Under bed storage boxes
- Shower curtain and rings (not provided by University Housing)
- 3M Command Adhesive hooks

Coordinate with your roommate:

- Cleaning supplies (nothing abrasive)
- Iron and ironing board
- Dry erase or bulletin board (provided in Bell Hall)
- Area rug
- Curtains and tension rods (blinds are provided)
- Broom and dustpan or mini vacuum
- Can opener
- Television and DVD player
- Dishes and utensils
- Mini-fridge no larger than 4.3 cubic ft.
- Microwave (1 per room 800 watts max.)

Personal items:

- Clothes hangers
- Radio / alarm clock
- Pillow, sheets, and comforter
- Bicycle lock Mattress pad / cover 36" X 80" (X-Long)
- Toilet paper
- Towels and washcloths
- Laundry bag, basket
- Toiletries
- Small sewing kit
- Medications
- Flashlight
- Small tool kit (hammer, screw drivers, wrench, tape measure)
- First aid kit
- Desk Lamp (LED bulbs recommended)

Apartment needs:

- Vacuum
- Pots and pans
- Shower curtain and rings
- Plunger
- Kitchen trash can and bags, additional bin for recycling
- Dish soap / dishwasher detergent
- Full sized bedding
- Small kitchen appliances (toaster, Foreman grill, etc.), Energy Star recommended

Things to leave home:

Candles, incense, halogen lamps, electric heaters, extension cords, weapons of any kind, animals or pets other than fish, alcohol, illegal drugs, homemade lofts, adhesive-backed hooks, wallpaper, contact paper, nails and screws. In the residence halls, cooking equipment with exposed heating elements (toasters, hot plates, etc.) is not permitted.
