



HOW TO SHELTER IN PLACE

DURING SEVERE WEATHER

In the event of a hurricane, tornado or other severe weather, Public Safety will issue a shelter-in-place order to all students, faculty and staff. To shelter in place safely, follow these steps:

- 01 GO INDOORS IMMEDIATELY**
Move to the lowest level.
- 02 AVOID WINDOWS, GLASS DOORS AND EXTERIOR WALLS**
Use interior hallways or stairwells if basements are not available.
- 03 AVOID ELEVATORS**
The power may go out.
- 04 BRING EMERGENCY SUPPLIES**
Phone, charger, water, flashlights, medications, etc.
- 05 AWAIT ALL-CLEAR ANNOUNCEMENT**
Remain in place and monitor campus alerts until an all-clear notice is issued.

Severe weather is **possible**.



TORNADO WATCH

A tornado is **possible**.

SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING

Severe weather, including hail and/or strong winds, has been **reported nearby**.

TORNADO WARNING

A tornado has been reported nearby.
