- A&S: Department of Philosophy, Religion and Liberal Studies. Modification in the Race and Social Justice Concentration. Change the Capstone requirement from a 3-hour course plus a 1-hour reflection paper to a 3-hour course and a 0-credit hour reflection paper. Effective Fall 2026.

 - Add sentence that will add clarification in the catalog that this is a “World Language” requirement, and courses such as Computer Science, American Sign Language, etc., will not fulfill this course.
