

SUMMER PARTS OF TERM

The Summer semester at Georgia College & State University includes seven shorter parts of term: Full Term, May, June, July, May-June, June-July, and a separate term for our Bridge Scholars Program. These parts of term are listed in the semester schedule and on student schedules. All information on this calendar is dependent on the part of term that a course is offered.

FRIDAY COURSE MEETINGS

Beginning Summer 2026, classes that meet face-to-face or synchronously online will have Friday class meetings unless Friday falls on a holiday.

COURSE LOAD

Summer courses are taught on an accelerated schedule and are extremely fast paced. Students are expected to complete the same amount of work as students who take the same course during the Fall or Spring semesters. For a standard three credit hour course, this amounts to 45 hours of class time (or an online equivalent) and at least 90 hours of preparation and study time during the duration of the course. For this reason, students are **strongly encouraged** to enroll in no more than two courses in any part of term, unless those courses are part of an integrated cohort program.

SUMMER GRADES AND GRADUATION

Grades for all Summer courses will be due at the end of the Summer semester on Monday, August 2, 2027, at 9:00 AM. Any incomplete or in progress grades due by the end of the Summer term must also be submitted by this date. Transcripts with Summer grades will be available beginning Tuesday, August 3, 2027. Grades are only available on official transcripts at the end of the semester, **not when the work is completed**.

Students graduating during the Summer term must satisfactorily complete all coursework, assessments, and other requirements by the last day of classes on Tuesday, July 27, 2027. Degrees will be posted for students who completed all remaining requirements during any part of the Summer semester beginning Tuesday, August 3, 2027, and will continue through the week. Degrees are only posted at the end of the Summer term, **not when requirements are finished**. Students who need verification that their coursework or degree is complete but for whom official transcripts are not yet available may contact the Registrar's Office for a verification letter once their instructors have submitted final grades for each course.

OBSERVANCE OF RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS

Georgia College & State University values the religious diversity of our students. Major religious holidays are listed and described on [this interfaith calendar](#). Students are permitted to miss class in observance of religious holidays and other activities observed by a religious group of which the student is a member without academic penalty. Students who will miss class in observance of a religious holiday or event are required to notify each instructor in writing within the first week of class of the semester in which the observance occurs and to make up the coursework missed as a result of the absence.
