## What is Modern Campus Curriculum?

- A curriculum management system used to create, review, and approve academic proposals
- Centralized platform to manage every aspect of the curriculum lifecycle:
  - Course changes
  - Program changes
  - New program proposals
- Provides a structured, transparent workflow

## Purpose of Modern Campus Curriculum?

- Ensures **consistency and accuracy** in curriculum development and management
- Supports **shared governance**
- Tracks **approval history and documentation**
- Aligns curriculum with:
  - Institutional goals
  - Accreditation requirements
  - System-level policies (USG, etc.)



## Benefits of an Integrated Modern Campus Curriculum

- Streamlines curriculum processes
- Supports timely catalog changes and updates
- Improves communication within and across departments
- Maintains compliance with academic policies
- Provides a clear audit trail for approvals


