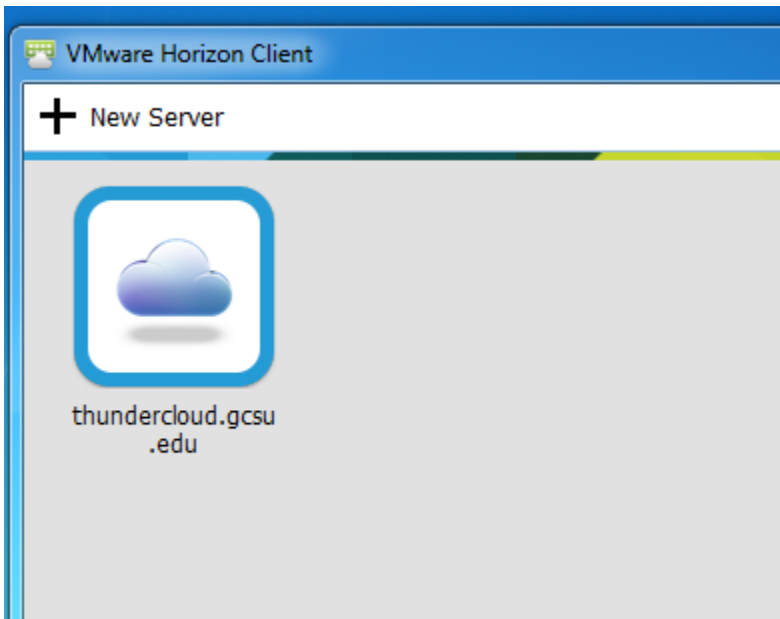


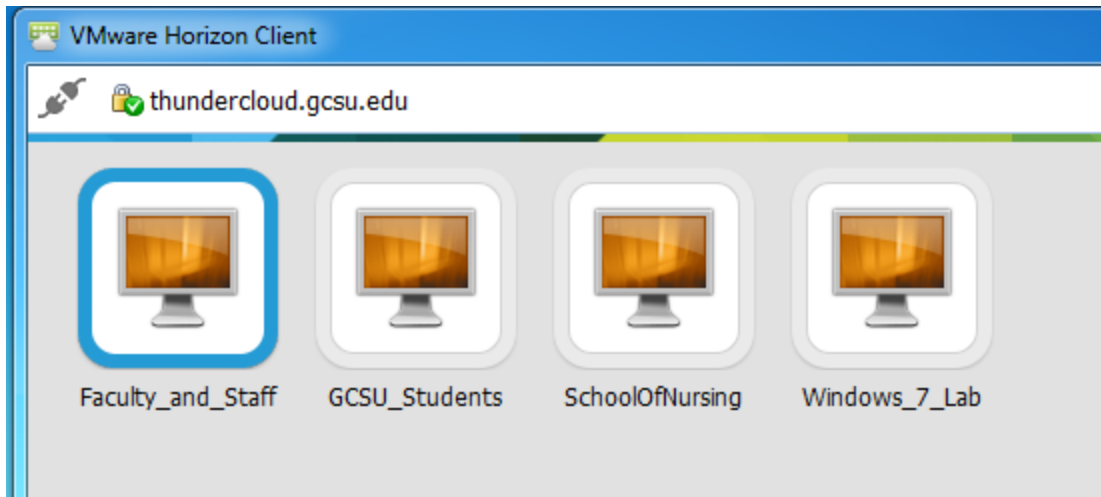


After the computer restart, use the VMware icon to access Thundercloud

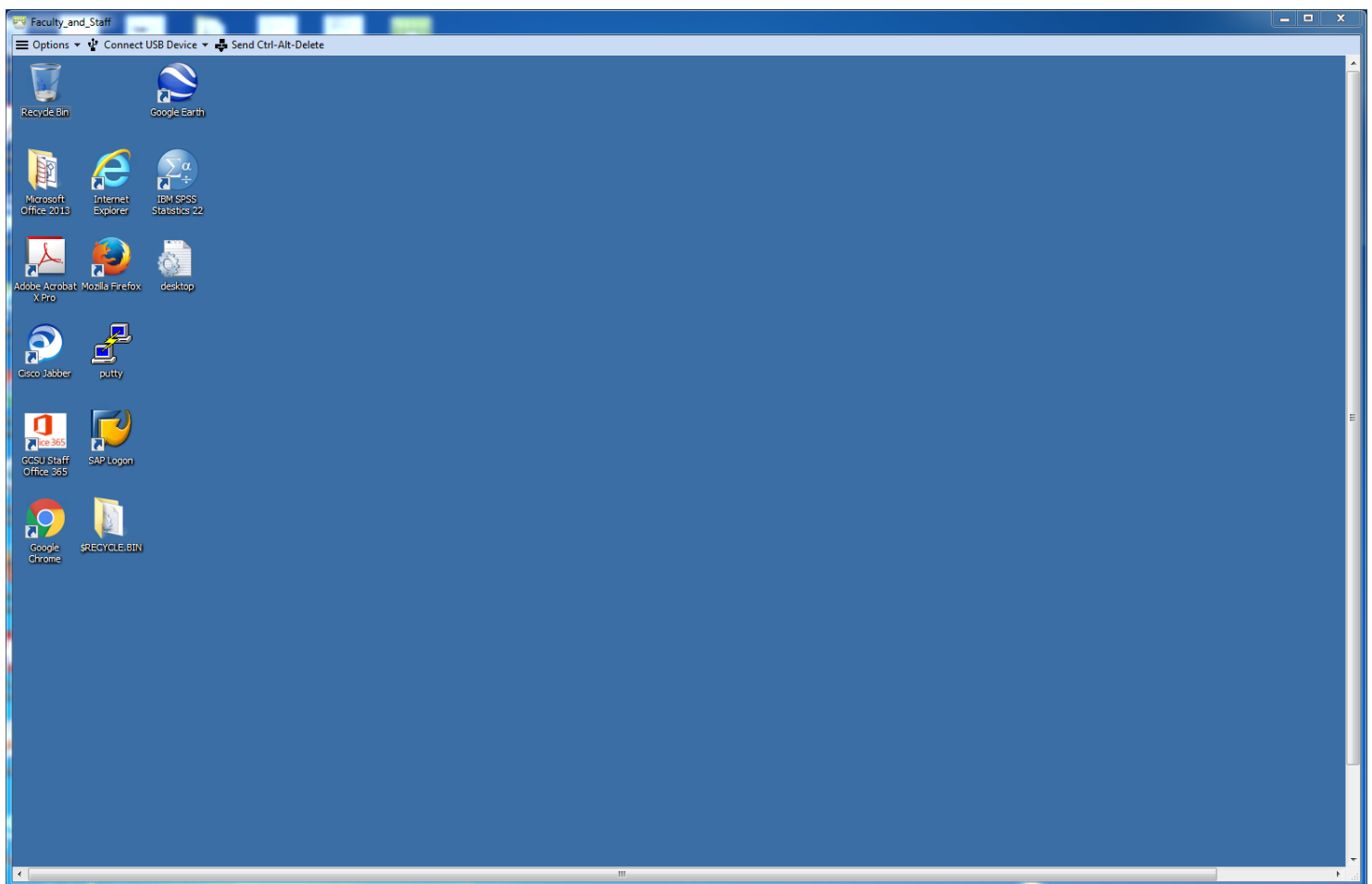

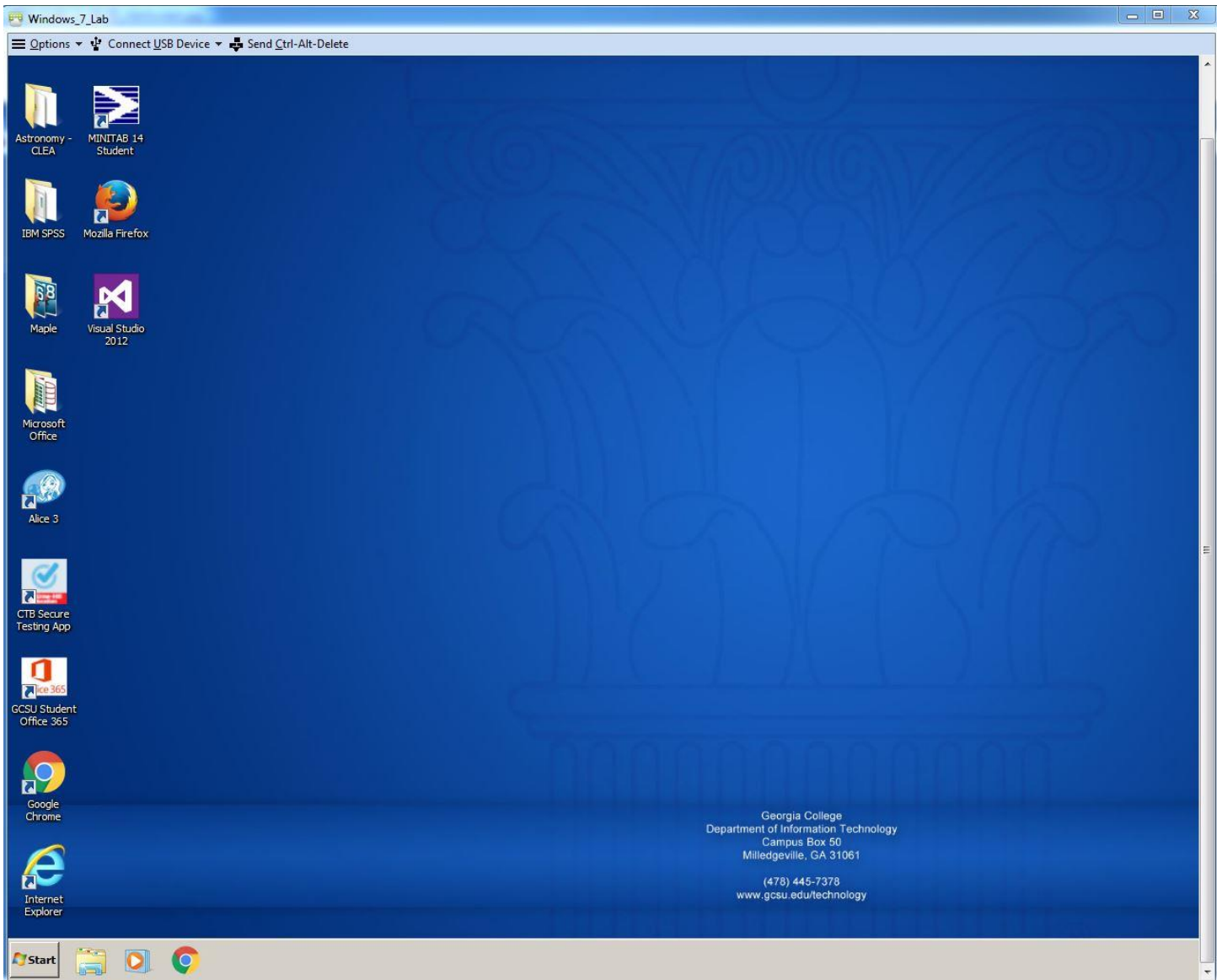
