The College Level Examination Program (CLEP) is a national program of credit that allows students to obtain recognition for college-level achievement.

Georgia College's Center for Testing is an open CLEP center and can administer all General Subject Examinations.

An original College Grade Report must be sent from The College Board directly to Georgia College (CEEB 5252) in order to receive credit. This request may be made when students register for the exam. A "K" grade will be awarded for CLEP credit. This grade will not affect the student's grade point average but will count toward total hours and will fulfill degree requirements.

The following equivalencies are effective for students taking CLEP exams in Fall 2020. **Equivalencies for future students are subject to change as a result of changes in CLEP test content and Georgia College course/curriculum changes.**

If you are taken a CLEP exam and hope to receive credit at another institution, check that institution's policies before testing.
