



Certification of Leadership Role or Position

Persons admitted to the Educational Leadership program at the 6th year (EdS) level must be in a Leadership role or position in order to complete the requirements of the Performance Based Residency. A leadership role or position is defined by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (505-2-.300) as follows:

Leadership role: A *role* does not require leadership certification and individuals do not necessarily have authority or supervisory responsibilities but must be assigned to leadership roles at the school or school system level to complete program residency requirements. The assignment of leadership responsibilities to an individual in a leadership role carries with it no promise of a future leadership position and no promise of compensation beyond what the local board of education would normally pay.

Leadership position: Positions requiring a leadership certificate are those in which an individual has the authority and/or responsibility, in a supervisory role, for board-approved educational programs and/or certified personnel.
