

Spring 2020 Admitted Students' Frequently Asked Questions

My acceptance letter said I was admitted for Spring 2020. Was that a mistake on the letter? Did I accidentally apply for Spring on my application?

No. You were reviewed for admission for the Fall 2019 term that you indicated on your application, but ultimately offered admission for the Spring 2020 semester.

Is there any way my acceptance can still be considered for Summer 2019 or Fall 2019?

No. Your admission is only valid for Spring 2020.

Can I take classes at another college or university in Fall 2019 that count toward my degree at Georgia College?

Yes! Many students who start in Spring will attend another college or university in the Fall in order to make sure they are still on track to graduate with their peers. Other students may choose to use these few months to work, study abroad, or volunteer with an organization. If you choose to attend another university in the Fall, be sure to include this information on the Spring Verification Form.

How will I know that the classes I take at another institution will transfer to Georgia College?

Before registering for a class at another college or university, refer to our online transfer equivalency information to determine whether or not you will receive credit for that class at GC.

If I attend another college in the Fall, will my student loans and/or HOPE scholarship transfer to Georgia College when I start in the Spring?

Yes! As long as you are in good standing at the college you attended in the Fall, student loans and the HOPE scholarship can be applied to GC for your start in the Spring.

Will I still be able to live in a residence hall if I start in the Spring?

Yes! All first year students are required to live on campus, including those students who start in the Spring.

Should I attend a summer orientation session?

No. Summer orientations are designed for those students starting in Fall 2019. You will have a specific orientation in January before classes begin.

How do I register for classes?

After confirming your enrollment, you will receive information on how to register.
