I am the largest meat-eating fish that ever lived. I swam the world's oceans about 24 to 1.7 million years ago.

Who Am I?

I am a member of the second largest group of invertebrates. I am protected by a shell, but have a soft body.

Who Am I?

---

I am an invertebrate animal with a hard exoskeleton made of calcium carbonate. There are over 6,000 fossil species of me. I live in the ocean.

Who Am I?

---

I am an invertebrate that lived in the shallow waters of the Paleozoic Sea for more than 300 million years, but became extinct during the mass extinctions at the end of the Permian Era.

Who Am I?

---

I had flight feathers similar to those of a modern bird, but my skeleton was more like a small Theropod Dinosaur.

Who Am I?

---

I am a short legged herbivore with fur that thrived in the Oligocene and early Miocene of North and Central America.

Who Am I?

---

I am a reptile, and the fossil found of me in Georgia's Hardie Mine is the oldest fossil of my kind to ever be found in North America, if not the world.

Who Am I?

---

I am a bird that can lift up to ten pounds of prey, which often consists of sloths and monkeys.

Who Am I?

---

I lived in Europe during the Ice Age, and hibernated in Alpine Caves, I was hunted by Neanderthal people, and my bones were often times used in their rituals.

I lived in North America throughout most of the Ice Age, and had massive, bony horns. I became extinct approximately 10,000 years ago.
