

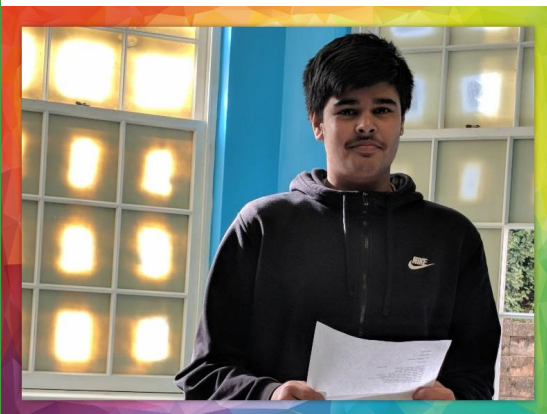

The three photographs above demonstrate students actively participating in our spoken word performance day, known as Poetry Cafe. Throughout the duration of our poetry unit, my 9th graders created a variety of poems that they revised, edited, and published. After undergoing this elongated scaffolding process, students were able to choose their favorite poem to perform in front of their class. Students brought hors d'oeuvres to share, listened to the soft tones of acoustic music, snapped in encouragement, and gave supportive commentary to each performer. This entire experience positively demonstrates students practicing skills that they will need in their adult life including: creative expression, writing, presentation, and provision of constructive feedback.

___ Water bottle (very important on hot days in spring and fall)
