



Dr. Theresa Magpuri-Lavell is the Executive Director of the Sandra Dungan Deal Center for Early Language and Literacy at Georgia College. Prior to Georgia College, Dr. Magpuri-Lavell served as an Associate Professor, Assistant Dean of Outreach, and as the Scholar in Residence for Jefferson County Public Schools in the School of Education at Bellarmine University in Louisville, KY.
